## Creative Recycling Systems

The e-Scrap contract period for January 2009 through July 2012 brought the total pounds collected to 10,528,461 lbs. or 5,264 net tons. Reimbursements climbed to \$372,565.18, with charges of \$115,652.43. The net revenue to generators for the period was \$256,532.60.
